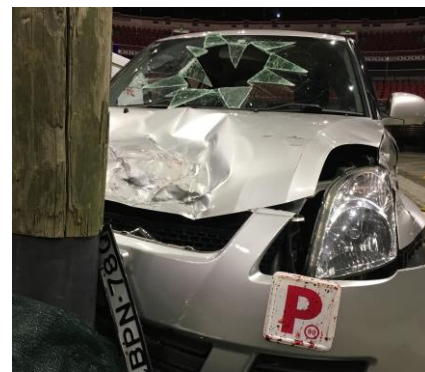
**No cancellations permitted after this time.** For seating purposes, please advise the number of teachers that will accompany the students to the event.
