Parking:

Parking is in the P1 carpark. The cost is fully subsidised by bstreetsmart.

Parking tickets must be handed in to the staff at the External Cloakroom <u>first thing</u> in the morning when you get wrist band and you will be able to pick up a subsidized ticket in return. Please make sure you do this early in the morning as the Qudos Bank Arena Staff will only be giving us the tickets once a day. When at the External Cloakroom you will be given a wristband for identification purposes and will be required to complete a Venue Safety Card. Please ensure your display is set up prior to students arriving from 9am.

Bump in times:

For Interactive displays with cars as part of their display, bump in must be done during the following times:

- Cars bump in for Concourse (through the main doors via Olympic Boulevard)
 - o Monday 1400 1500
 - o Tuesday 0630 0800
- General bump in (it is via the loading dock off Edwin Flack Avenue)
 - o Monday 1200 1600
 - Tuesday 0630 0800

Your allocated areas will be marked on the map given to you and will be available on the website when it is completed.

Bump out on Thursday needs to be done after the students have all left, after 2 pm. This will be strictly adhered to particularly for any cars that need to be driven around the concourse. Bump out must be completely finished by Thursday.

Teachers Packs:

All displays are encouraged to put together teacher's packs for the teachers to take back to school and continue the road safety message education to the students. These can be delivered to the teacher's lounge area.

Total number of schools currently booked in over the 3 days is 215 – therefore possibly need to put together that many packs.

Handouts:

Please be cognisant of what your organisation is giving as handouts to the students. There cannot be any stickers (as per Qudos Bank Arena instructions) as they end up stuck on walls and mirrors. Balloons turn into water bombs and CD's turn into Frisbees.

Counsellors:

Generous support from the WMH Social Work Department and Youth Health Services. There will be 4 on per day. T-shirts purchased for any unfortunate "protein spills"

Interactive display requirements:

If your display requires power, you will need to bring along your own extension cord & power boards. All cords must be taped to the floor **BUT** you need to get special terrazzo tape supplied by Qudos Bank Arena. We will purchase rolls of tape for you to use. If using Wi-Fi there will be a charge amount unknown at this stage. Displays will be on both levels
