Last year 209 schools from NSW & ACT attended with 23,504 students. In addition, over 61 schools watched lived & 480 downloaded views post event.

The forum is run by the Westmead Hospital Trauma Service for school years 10 – 12 with the specific purpose of educating our youth and reducing road fatalities and injuries in this high risk group.
