Last year 206 schools attended with 23,053 students. 9 schools remained on the waiting list. 98 schools watched live. Over 500 downloaded views

The program consists of a dramatic live crash re-enactment that includes Police, Ambulance Service of NSW and Fire & Rescue. Interactive displays and crash survivor speakers bring home the road safety message with passion and clarity. The forum is run by the Westmead Hospital Trauma Service for school years 10 – 12 with the specific purpose of educating our youth and reducing road fatalities and injuries in this high risk group.

bstreetsmart proudly won the Australian Road Safety Award (2014 & 2017) and the Western Sydney LHD Quality Award (2016) and has been finalists in the NSW Premier Awards (2007, 2013), the Australian Road Safety Award (2011, 2012 & 2016) and Western Sydney LHD Quality Award (2013). The program has been running for 14 years so you can be assured your students will be attending a top quality learning experience.
