Absolutely no cancellations permitted after this time. Please note: ONCE INVOICE IS PAID, NO REFUNDS PERMITTED.

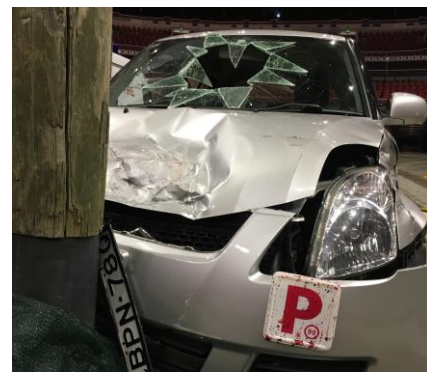
For seating purposes, please advise the number of teachers accompanying the students on the day.
