# **Melissa McGuinness Back!**

"Jordan was smart. Jordan was funny. Jordan was a great person, but none of that means anything now. None of it," Mrs McGuinness tells the teenagers sitting in silence before her, some with their faces in their hands, more than a few crying.

"That's because he defined himself by his choices that night. He shaped a terrible and permanent legacy for himself, his family and his victims' families because he chose to drink, smoke [marijuana] and speed down that highway. "And everything he did before that just pales in comparison." Melissa speaks with such passion and conviction whilst telling her own story of being stuck in her prism of grief.
